ALL NON-ASCA DOGS MUST HAVE A TRACKING NUMBER TO ENTER THE ASCA OBEDIENCE TRIALS AND HAVE THE RESULTS OF THEIR RUNS COUNT TOWARD TITLE(S). Forms are available at www.asca.org Non –ASCA dogs may enter the obedience trial(s) without a tracking number; however, only those with a tracking number will be awarded ASCA titles upon completing the title requirements.

GENERAL INFORMATION: These events are sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America; all ASCA rules apply (www.asca.org). Dogs over 6 months of age must have proof of ASCA registration available. All dogs' ages will be calculated on the day of the show. HPASC, the Show Secretary/ies, Show Stewards, and club membership assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by any exhibitor, handler, dog, property, children or spectator. All dogs must be crated or leashed. Children are to be supervised at all times. Entry fees will not be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of HPASC. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the Show Committee, ASCA, show veterinarian or the judge.

◀ **Pre-Entry Deadline:** Postmark no later than **JUNE 27, 2010**. Telephone, facsimile, e-mail or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries *must* be on the official ASCA entry form with proper fees included. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of the entry and class entered. Withdrawals of entries will be accepted until the Pre-Entry closing; thereafter, no refunds will be made. HPASC is not responsible for entries that are not received.

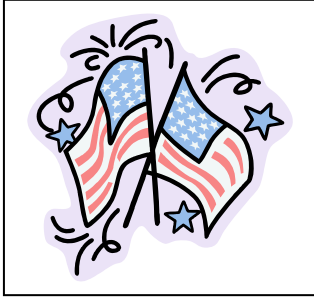

◀ **AWARDS OFFERED:** HPASC will be providing trophies and/or ribbons as outlined below:

Conformation Trophies: Altered and Regular: Best of Breed; Best Opposite Sex; Winners Dog and Winners Bitch; Best Junior Handler; Reserve Junior Handler; Best of Breed Puppy and Best of Opposite Sex Puppy; Best of Breed Veteran.

Obedience Trophies: High in Trial Overall and either High in Trial Aussie or Other Breed (whichever is not High in Trial Overall) and High in Trial – Junior Handler.

Conformation and Obedience Ribbons: Flat ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each class. Deluxe rosettes for HIT Junior, HIT Aussie and HIT Other Breed. Conformation-BOB, BOW, BOS, WD, WB, RWD, RWB, Best Junior Handler, Reserve Junior Handler, BOB Puppy and BOS Puppy, BOB Veteran

◀ DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE – ADAMS COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS – HENDERSON (BRIGHTON) COLORADO:

- **FROM 1-25 NORTH OR SOUTH:** Take I-76 East to US Highway 85. Go north on Hwy. 85 to 124th Avenue (mile marker 230). Turn left (west) on 124th Avenue. Continue west on 124th Avenue (which becomes Henderson Road after the stop sign.) Proceed straight on Henderson Road to Adams County Fairgrounds. Turn right into the Fairgrounds.
- **FROM HIGHWAY 7** – Take Highway 7 to U.S. Highway 85. Go south on Highway 85 to 124th Avenue (mile marker 230). Turn right (west) on 124th Avenue. Continue west on 124th Avenue (which becomes Henderson Road after the stop sign.) Proceed straight on Henderson Road to Adams County Fairgrounds. Turn right into the Fairgrounds.
