All dogs must be crated or leashed. Children are to be supervised at all times. Entry fees will not be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of HPASC. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the Show Committee, ASCA, show veterinarian or the judge.



All entries must be on the official ASCA entry form with proper fees included. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of the entry and class entered. Withdrawals of entries will be accepted until the Pre-Entry closing; thereafter, no refunds will be made. HPASC is not responsible for entries that are not received.
